TFF is dedicated to the memory of Bah Agwo Fomunyoh, grandfather of TFF's founder and a man of courage and wisdom who lived through German, English and French colonization, and in his time sought to right the wrongs inflicted on ordinary citizens.

Mission

The mission of the Fomunyoh Foundation is to improve the quality of life of Cameroonian people through the implementation of public health, education and community outreach programs. The Foundation provides technical and financial assistance to individuals, associations and organizations dedicated to the promotion of democracy and human rights in the Republic of Cameroon.
